Centre for Health Informatics of National Health Portal (NHP)

- The Centre for Health Informatics (CHI) has developed "Nutri-App" in collaboration with Indian Dietetic Association, "JSK Mobile App" as per inputs provided by Jansankhya Sthirata Kosh. They have also developed a "Swasth Bharat Mobile App", under the guidance of MoHFW. Swasth Bharat Mobile App is a unified app in which all the mobile apps developed by the CHI are put under one umbrella.
- Information relating to the diseases of Intra-uterine growth restriction, Gaming disorder, Fibromyalgia, Congenital Capillary Haemangioma of Eyelid, Acquired Capillary Haemangioma of Eyelid, Cavernous Haemangioma of Eyelid and First-Aid module on Snake bite were added in the NHP.
- Added ten health days in the Health Wellness Calendar of the portal namely: World Leprosy Day, World
 Cancer Day, International Day of Zero Tolerance to Female Genital Mutilation, National Deworming
 Day, Sexual and Reproductive Health Awareness Day, International Women's Day, World Kidney Day,
 World Down Syndrome Day, World Water Day and World Tuberculosis Day.
- Organised extensive multimedia digital campaign for four weeks during the month of February-March, 2018. This campaign was specially organised for promotion of health care/health literacy and for generating awareness of the people across the country.

National Health Mission/RCH

- An annual review meeting of Directors/Principals of Collaborating Training Institutes (CTIs) was held on January 29, 2018 at NIHFW. The issue of how to rollout the Short-Term Skill Development Courses in the States/UTs' was discussed in the meeting.
- The RCH unit reviewed State Programme Implementation Plan 2018-19 for States/UTs. The comments and suggestions on the same have been submitted for the States of Madhya Pradesh, Delhi, West Bengal, Chhattisgarh, Himachal Pradesh and Telangana.
- Quarterly Progress Report for 3rd Quarter (October December 2017) was prepared and submitted to MoHFW. The Training Progress Reports for 4th quarter (January- March 2018) have been received from the States/UTs and are being analyzed and compiled.
- Ten monitoring visits were conducted to monitor the quality of ongoing trainings in different States/UTs.
- In order to improve the quality of trainings, twenty-four monitoring visits were made by the consultants of SIHFW/CTIs for the States/UTs and the feedback and recommendations for improvements have been shared with all concerned.

Nursing and other Visits

A total of 874 nursing students and 32 faculty from 16 Institutions visited the NIHFW. A brief orientation programme was held for them regarding various activities of the Institute and other issues related to health in the country. In addition, 09 post-graduate students from 02 Institutes also visited the NIHFW.
