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Introduction

A critical aspect of the scientific process is the reporting of new results in scientific journals in order to disseminate information to the larger community of scientists. Communication of the results contributes to the pool of existing knowledge. Often it provides scientific knowledge for future research. Communicating research findings in peer reviewed journal is a prerequisite skill for every public health personnel. This Scientific Writing Training Course is designed to help health professionals to document their researches. The learning from the training will upgrade their skills to effectively communicate their research findings.

Objectives

- To discuss the process of writing research paper for publication.
- To be able to write various sections of a Scientific Manuscript.

Course Contents

- Drafting of Manuscript.
- Writing Title, Abstract, Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion
- Authorship & Ethics
- References/Acknowledgements.
- Communicating with the editor.

Methodology

The course consists of “learning by guided practice” and has lectures, discussions, exercises, and group work sessions. The participants will bring a report/findings of a study conducted by them. After presentation in each session there will be group work where, participants will discuss on the relevant section in the session from the report/finding with them. At the end of the course the participant will prepare a draft paper and present in plenary.
