

Training Activities 2009-2010

NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (NIHFW) came into existence on March 9, 1977 after the merger of two erstwhile institutions namely; National Institute of Health Administration and Education (NIHAE) and National Institute of Family Planning (NIFP). It acts as an 'apex technical Institute' as well as a 'think tank' for the promotion of health and family welfare programmes in the country and known for its education, training, research, evaluation and consultancy, advisory and other specialized services.

Post-graduate Training

The training activities of the Institute contribute to health manpower development for better management of health and family welfare programmes in the country. These courses are need-based and multi-disciplinary in nature. They include (i) a three-year Post-Graduate Degree M.D. in Community Health Administration; (ii) a two-year Post-Graduate Diploma in Health Administration; (iii) two Post-Graduate Certificate Courses, one year-each, in Health and Family Welfare Management and Hospital Management through Distance Learning; and (iv) One-year Post-graduate Diploma in Public Health Management.

Training and Workshop

The training courses and workshops (intra-mural and extra-mural), numbering around 40-50 organized by the Institute every year aim at (i) familiarizing the participants with the goals and objectives of health and family welfare programmes; (ii) updating their knowledge and understanding of operational difficulties in implementation; and (iii) suggesting remedial measures to overcome such constraints.

Research and Evaluation

The Institute gives priority to research in different aspects of health and family welfare. Most of the research studies are initiated by the Institute while a few of them are sponsored by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and other collaborating national and international agencies.

Specialised Services

Specialised services of the Institute include clinical, documentation, printing and publications. The clinical works in relation to infertility, reproductive disorders, especially endocrinology and sexual dysfunctions deserve mention. The reference, referral, press clipping and bibliographic services of NDC and the publication, art and projection services of the department of communication compliment the activities of the Institute.

Public Health Education and Research Consortium

'Public Health Education and Research Consortium - Network and Partnership' has been developed with the objective of sharing experiences and promoting public health in the country. The Consortium includes medical colleges, nursing colleges, SIHFWs/CTIs and NGOs as partners. The main objectives of the consortium are sharing of information on programme guidelines, record updates through print and electronic media and capacity development of the partners through research methodology workshops and rapid appraisal methods for research.

Advisory and Consultancy Services

The Director and faculty members of the Institute provide advisory and consultancy services to various national, international and voluntary organizations in various capacities.
